#### **STUDY TIMELINE**

- April 2024 October 2024: 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of the study (the Interim Phase) where we focus on analysis of the impact areas, including via consultations with stakeholders.
- April/May 2024 September 2024: online surveys (OPC and business/SME) will be available for stakeholders share their opinions about the Agreement.
- October-December 2024: Online seminars at EU Member State level, and two special online seminars: one for SMEs and one for Canadian stakeholders.
- October 2024 March 2025: final phase of the study, where we continue to engage with stakeholders and prepare the (draft) final report.

### **CETA-RELATED EVENTS**

- 9 February 2024: The fourth Joint Committee meeting on CETA took place and concluded that :1) EU-Canada trade has grown by over 50% since 2017; 2) Trade in services and investment have gone up; 3) Is helping EU and Canadian SMEs; 4) Both economies have become more resilient; and 5) The Agreement has supported diversification of supply chains and collaboration on critical raw materials.
- **9 March 2024:** The EU-Canada dialogue on raw materials took place, discussing the state of implementation of the Strategic Partnership on Raw Materials.
- **18-19 March 2024:** The *CETA Civil Society Forum* took place (with the Domestic Advisory Groups) with a focus on environment & climate change, collaboration on labour, discussions on business and human rights, and trade, gender & SMEs.
